

Health Screen and Background Check Requirements for Medical Interpreting Check List

Vaccines

Please provide documentation of the following (can be immunization records or a current blood test showing immunity):

- Measles** – Born before 1957 consider immune; or Documentation of (2) measles vaccine (MMR) and/or (+) titer.
- Mumps** – Born before 1957 consider immune; or Documentation of (2) Mumps vaccine (MMR) and/or (+) titer.
- Rubella** – Born before 1957 consider immune or MMR vaccine (1) or Rubella vaccine (1).
- Chickenpox (Varicella)** – (+) titer or Documentation of (2) Varivax vaccines.
- Pertussis Vaccine (Tdap)** – Adult dose (1) since 2008 or Declination of Vaccination form (ask for the decline form if you are declining).
- Annual Influenza vaccine documentation** – Vaccination or Declination of Vaccination form (ask for the decline form if you are declining).
- Hep B** – Provide documentation of vaccination, Proof of Titers or Declination of Vaccination form (ask for the decline form if you are declining).

Tests and Screenings

- Criminal Background Check**
 - You can go to [this link](#) and use the company we have set up a relationship with.
- TB surveillance** – (2-step) baseline PPD/TB (-) within the last year. If history of a (+) PPD, please provide documentation of chest x-ray report within last 12 months and a negative symptom review.
- Drug Screen Clearance Test** called 10 panel + alcohol.
 - Kaiser can do this if you are a member. Be sure to ask how much it is depending on your coverage.
 - Best to shop around. We have no forms to provide. Just explain you are an independent contractor that is required to have this to work in medical settings.
 - We have an account with a provider that has the cost for this screening under \$40. If this is less than your option then go to [this link](#) and follow instructions.

- Your Resume.**
- A copy of your current CEU cycle transcripts from RID. To be sent annually. Ask for information on how, if needed.**
- Your current RID card.**
- A digital photo for an ID badge to be worn at all medical appointments.**
